

Our focus is maintaining in person learning for all students while adjusting mitigation strategies given our local data. As we learned last year, it is possible for grade levels/buildings to be in different stages throughout the year. Our COVID Incident Management Team will meet weekly to review data and recommend changes, if needed, to our mitigation measures. Data points to consider may include <u>county data</u> (7-day case rate, community transmission, and location of community cases) for both Benton and Stearns counties and <u>district data</u> (positive staff and student numbers, counts by location, staff absences, etc). As new information or data becomes available, the SRR COVID Stages chart may change.
